Fees & Reservations

You don't need reservations to visit or enter Yosemite National Park, but reservations for lodging or camping are necessary if you plan to spend the night in the park.

All visitors must pay the park entrance fee*. If you arrive in your private car, van, pickup truck, or RV, the entrance fee is \$20 per car. This is valid* for unlimited entries* to Yosemite for seven days, and covers all of the members in the same car.

For those not arriving by car, entrance fees are as follows:

\$10 per person if arriving on foot, horseback, bicycle, motorcycle, or on a non-commercial bus (free for those 15 years old and younger) .

We accept cash, checks, traveler's checks, and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover) .

No Entrance fee on:

- January 14-16 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Day)
- April 21-29 (National Park Week)
- June 9 (Get Outdoors Day)
- September 29 (National Public Lands Day)
- November 10-12 (Veterans Day weekend)

Senior Pass: \$10

This is a lifetime admission* for US citizens who are age 62 or older. (You can also get this pass by mail for another \$10.)
